## ATHLETIC GUIDELINES

The athletic programs of Creighton Community School are designed to provide the opportunity for those students who desire competitive activities. All students are welcome to try out for any interscholastic program, provided they meet the requirements established by the Nebraska School Activities Association and the Creighton Board of Education.

## Requirements of NSAA:

- 1. Physical examination- satisfactory medical finding must be met. (Cost of physical examination for the athletic program will be paid by the student.)
- 2. Parental/Guardian permission
- 3. Insurance statement-insurance requirements must be fulfilled.
- 4. Eligibility requirements-scholastic standards of association

## Requirements of Creighton Board of Education:

- 1. Attendance at practice is required unless excused by the coach or because of illness.
- 2. Athletes will be neat, clean, and well-groomed, and will display personal conduct of good sportsmanship in situations where they are representing the school. The school administration assumes that the athlete has been taught acceptable levels of moral and physical personal hygiene at the athlete's home, and that the school coaches are not required to provide the athlete with a list of the things that do and do not constitute acceptable cleanliness practices, moral, and physical. It the athlete believes he or she has not been taught at home well enough to know what our society considers acceptable, the athlete should inform the Athletic Director and suitable schooling will be arranged with an appropriate minister, priest, or family counselor.

## Scheduling of Athletic Contests

- 1. No athletic contest will be scheduled without the authorization of the Administration and Athletic Director.
- 2. A balance between the number of games played at home and away will be maintained in so far as possible.
- 3. An effort will be made to schedule schools of comparable size.
- 4. The rules set forth by the Nebraska Schools Activities Association will be followed as to number of games played during the season of each sport and the beginning and completion dates of each sport including practice.
