

Message Regarding eLearning Shared on March 26th

Creighton Community School is transitioning away from e-Enrichment and moving into the elearning environment beginning March 30th. An elearning environment is slightly different because work is graded and also required. As we make this transition, students should see few changes to the learning environment they have worked on since March 18th. Seesaw and Google Classroom will remain the primary vehicles for delivery with instruction and discussion occurring through zoom meetings.

During these uncertain times, we recognize that every family has unique learning environments at home. With that in mind, assignments will be shorter and less frequent than in a regular classroom setting. During the closure period, we encourage parents and students to reach out to the specific classroom teacher with questions regarding an assignment or a requirement. We will continue working with families that have limited or no internet service.

It is vital that every parent and every student is aware that assignments are required and will become part of each student's final grade.
